This concert special also follows Sir Gilbert as he travels to Buenos Aires, Venice, Kraków, Rome, Vienna, and Washington, D.C., to show us all how music and spirit can unite our world. The concert, performed in Washington, D.C., in May 2014, following Pope Francis' ceremony to make Pope John XXIII and Pope John Paul II saints. The program will air on WITF TV, on Easter Sunday, April 5 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. It will air on WVIA TV on Saturday, April 4 at 9 p.m. and Easter Sunday, April 5 at 5 p.m.
